When I told my NCC instructor, I expected disappointment. Instead, she said, "You've got potential. You'll shine in college." Those words gave me strength I didn't know I had.

This camp taught me that failure isn't a weakness - it's training. It teaches you focus, calm, and courage. I may have missed the medal that day. But I returned with something greater: a sharper aim, and an even stronger will.
